## for the following articles:

Yarns made of natural fibres (wool, alpaka, cotton, viscose, LENZING™ Lyocell, silk, viscose from bamboo pulp, LENZING™ Viscose FR), synthetic fibres (polyamide, polyester, polyester monofilament with antistatic properties, acrylic, polypropylene) or their blends, dyed and undyed, partly with finishings (Teflon™, Self clean); partly finished with biological active products accepted by OEKO-TEX®; partly produced with fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties; produced by using materials certified according to Standard 100 by OEKO-TEX®. Note: Various tested raw white articles with acrylic fibres may contain more than 0,1 % (but max. 1.5 %) of DMAc/DMF and have to undergo further industrial production stages (heat process in wet or dry stage is preferred, but also other steps are possible). Afterwards new tests for the presence of DMAc/DMF (max. 0,1 %) are obligatory.


The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Appendix 6, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Appendix 6 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
